2024 CRMC Supplementary Regulations Appendix C

CRMC Club Championship Conditions 2024

1. Machine Eligibility:

Open to machines possessing a CRMC Eligibility Certificate and substantially unchanged from the specification declared on the requisite Eligibility Application Form.

2. Standard of Preparation:

In addition to being CRMC eligible competitors and / or entrants are expected to prepare their machines to a high standard in keeping with the Classic and Post Classic Periods.

3. Rounds:

Four rounds will be scheduled at each 2024 CRMC meeting except Croft where there will be three rounds and Anglesey where there will be two rounds. The results from all rounds will count for the Championship.

The third race of the weekend at Croft will count for double points.

The final two rounds of the Championships will be on the Saturday at Croft followed by the non-championship Classic Races of the Year on the Sunday.

It should be noted that races are frequently made up of more than one class and the combination may vary from meeting to meeting in line with varying support levels. It cannot be guaranteed that if you are competing in more than one championship, the classes you have entered will always be in separate races.

4. Points allocation:

Points will be awarded from 1st to 15th place on the following scale –

1st	2nd	3rd	4th	5th	6th	7th	8th	9th	10th	11th	12th	13th	14th	15th
25pt	20pt	16pt	13pt	11pt	10pt	9pt	8pt	7pt	6pt	5pt	4pt	3pt	2pt	1pt

In the event of a tie, the greater number of 1st places, 2nd places and so on will resolve the tie.

Note 1: Championship points for any round cannot be changed for any reason after the start of the meeting hosting the subsequent round. The onus is on the rider to ensure the points he has been awarded are correct and inform the championship co-ordinator if they are not.

Note 2: If a rider has entered two classes that are subsequently scheduled into the same race, then provided one of the bikes is eligible for both classes, points may be scored in both classes. This is to enable the secretary to schedule the most efficient race programme.

5. Awards:

Championship Trophies will be awarded to the winner, second & third, of each Championship Class at the CRMC Annual Dinner Dance.

Additional Championship Prize Money Awards for the following classes:

- 1. VJMC sponsored prize money will be awarded in Class 2a, 3a & 8h
- 2. Doug Perkins sponsored Prize Money will be awarded in the Sidecar Classes.

See appendix A and B for the ACU Championship awards.

6. Fuel:

Random fuel tests may be made during the season to check the legality of fuel used by competitors. Competitors must ensure that 2 litres of fuel remain in their machine at the end of the race in order that samples may be taken.

It is permitted to use fuel up to 105 RON, 95 MON octane & 2.7% oxygen provided the fuel meets all other ACU specifications. The use of E85 Bio-fuel is not permitted.

Failure to ensure sufficient fuel for testing, or failing the fuel test, will results in:

- 1. Disqualification from the results, loss of points scored to date and any Prize Money awarded to date.
- 2. Liability for the cost of the fuel test.

For further clarification consult the Championship co-ordinator.

7. Protests:

Any protests must be carried out as per instructions in the ACU handbook.

8. Sanctions:

Any competitor and/or entrant found to be in breach of sec 6 above will be excluded from the results and lose Championship points or awards for the meeting at which the offence occurred and all previous meetings.

Any competitor and/or entrant found to be in breach of sections 1 and/or 7 above will be excluded from the results and lose Championship points and/or awards for the meeting at which the offence occurred. Further sanctions may be applied at the discretion of the organisers.

9. Overall Interpretation:

The overall interpretation of the CRMC Club Championship rules 2024 is entirely the province of the CRMC management committee whose decisions will be final and binding.
