Riders briefing notes will be posted on the website Wednesday 25th September.

Paddock Access

Direct access to the paddock will be from 6.00pm. Competitors arriving between 4.00pm and 6.00pm will be admitted to the holding area on the hill overlooking the paddock. Please do not arrive at the circuit any earlier than 4.00pm as congestion causes serious safety issues on the B4080 and circuit approach road that will impact on future CRMC events at Anglesey.

Signing-on

Signing on for the CRMC meeting will be in the Race Office located on the ground floor of the pit lane complex adjacent to pit garage #6.

When you sign-on for the meeting please have your 2024 licence QR code available for inspection or your DVLA licence in the case of paraders. You will receive your technical control card/practice pass when you sign-on. This pass also indicates which practice session(s) you have been allocated.

Note: parade riders over 70 now require an ACU parade licence.

Noise Control

Every machine must be silenced to comply with the ACU limit of 105 dBa and will need to pass noise testing before racing commences on Saturday. Riders with more than one machine may noise test out of sequence.

If a queue develops for noise testing, then priority will be given to those arriving at the allotted time.

Technical Control (Scrutineering)

When you present the bike to technical control please:

- Have your technical control card and machine eligibility certificate with you.
- Have your machine numbered for racing with ACU compliant numbers.
- Sidecars to present their machines with the fairing removed.

The Technical Control Bay operates a one way system entering from the Café end and exiting at the paddock return end.

If you have an eligibility query, please contact the relevant Eligibility Officer listed on the CRMC web site

Podium Races

There are two ACU Championship and the Supermono National races on the Sunday that riders will, after the chequered flag, return to the Parc Ferme. The top three finishers in each class will then be garlanded and presented with awards at the adjacent podium.

- Race 14 Supermono National Championship Race
- Race 20 ACU Post Classic 750 Championship Race.

- Race 23 ACU Classic 500 Championship Race

Sunday's Race of the Year Events

Races 19 – 28 are the end of season Race of the Year events. Immediately after the race, the first three in each class will be presented with Race of the Year Slate trophies at the podium.

Each class winner will also receive a laurel garland.

Each class winner will also be presented with the Class Race of the Year trophy at the Dinner Dance to keep for one year.

Medical Centre

Should you need medical attention or require being passed fit to ride, the doctors can be found at the Medical car in the assembly area or medical portacabin next to assembly.

Paddock Security

Sadly, there was a theft from a competitor's vehicle at Croft and whilst this was unlikely to have been from within the CRMC community, it reminds us that this can happen, and to look out for each other particularly when riders go out to race/parade.

Paddock Parking

Please do not park behind the pit lane garages unless you have pre booked a garage.

Paddock Electric Hook Ups

Electric hook ups are available in most of the paddock and will be powered up from Friday evening.

It is essential that leads are taped down or covered especially where they cross roadways.

The Anglesey paddock does not have charging points for electric vehicles, nor does it permit electric vehicles to be trickle charged.

Paddock Catering Opening Times

The Pit Stop paddock café will be open-

- Friday evening 5.00pm till 9.00pm (if busy)
- Saturday and Sunday 7.30am till 9.00pm

Bar open Friday and Saturday evenings 5.00pm till end.

Procedure after a Fall

Riders are not permitted to remount and continue following a fall from their machine. Riders wishing to resume racing at the event must proceed direct to the Medical Centre to be passed fit to race. Those passed fit to race will have this information relayed to Race Control where the automatic stop on their racing will be lifted and the bike released from the Tech Bay.

Grid positions

Grid positions for the first race will be determined by fastest lap times set in timed practice Saturday.

Grid positions for the second and third races of the weekend will be set by fastest lap times set in the **first** race.

Dedicated timed qualifying will set the grids for the ACU Classic 500, Post Classic 750 and Supermono National races.

Riders may opt to start at the back of the grid if they wish, by consulting with the Clerk of the Course.

Transponders

If you have hired a transponder, it will be issued ready charged at signing-on. Mounting brackets are available from race office. You must have your transponder fitted during practice and racing. If you encounter problems with your own transponder, please see CRMC Race Office for a temporary replacement.

On board Cameras

Any rider wishing to carry on board video equipment needs written permission from the CRMC. Forms are available in the Technical Control Bay.

Trophy Presentation

Saturday's trophy presentation will be held approx 20 minutes after racing finishes on Saturday evening at the Technical Control Bay

Paddock Supplies and Consumables

TGA will be servicing the paddock with race consumables and tyres.

Windy Shed Classics will be servicing the paddock with race consumables including tyres and fitting. 97 octane fuel is available from the paddock fuel pump next to tech control.

Paddock Safety

Under 16's are not permitted to ride bicycles, scooters etc in the paddock whilst track activity is taking place.

Generators

If you are running a generator, please ensure it is switched off by 11.00pm at the latest.

Tyre Warmers

All competitors are reminded that the use of tyre warmers is not permitted at any time during CRMC race meetings.

Check list of items not to forget!!

- Admission tickets
- ACU Competition licence (Without it you may end up not being able to race).
- DVLA Licence for Paraders without a competition or over 70 parading licence.
- Eligibility certificate.
- A Fully charged transponder (Unless Parading or hiring a CRMC transponder)
- Fire Extinguisher

Above all please ensure you have a safe and enjoyable weekend's racing!
